GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

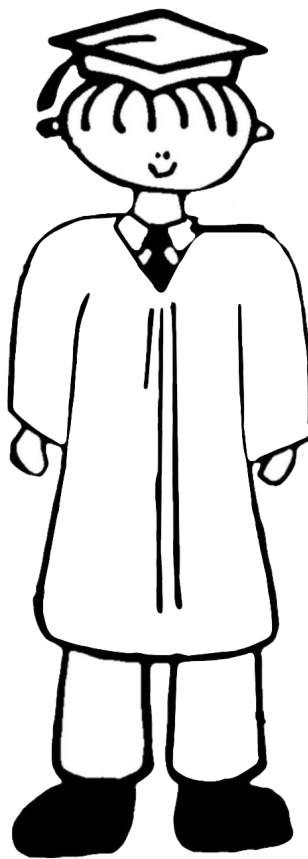
For a State of Hawaii Diploma, students must earn **24 credits** that include:

English	4
Social Studies	4
Math	3
Science	3
Physical Education	1
Health	1/2
Electives	6
World Lang, Fine Arts, or CTE	2
Personal Transition Plan	1/2

In addition to meeting the DOE requirements, Moanalua High School students must abide by the following expectations in order to participate in commencement exercises.

- Follow and obey all school and individual classroom rules
- Display appropriate and acceptable behavior towards others at all school functions
- Fulfill all financial obligations by April 2020. Abide by proper graduation attire and adhere to dress code

PROPER ATTIRE

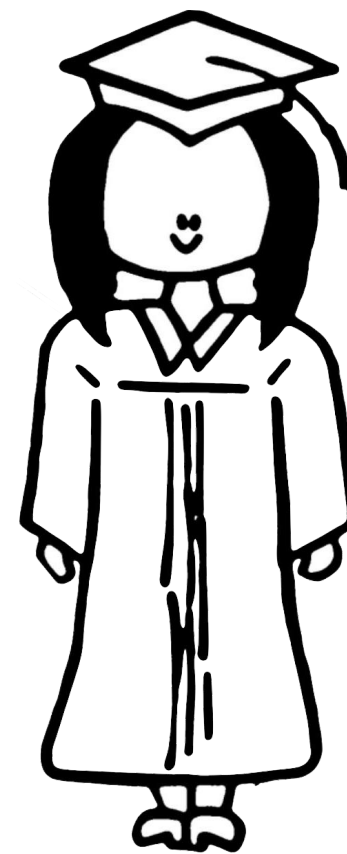


MALE

- Royal blue gown & cap
- Black or navy tie (no bow ties)
- Black dress pants (no jeans)
- Black socks
- Black dress shoes (no athletic shoes)
- White collared long-sleeve shirt

- Cap parallel to floor
- Gown hangs 8-12 in from the floor
- Sleeves at wrist or covers half of hand when arms hang at side

*No alterations or decorations to the cap or gown are allowed



FEMALE

- White gown & cap
- White dress with scoop or v-neck (no high collars)
- Nylons (optional) must be skin-toned colored
- White dress shoes (no stiletto heels)
