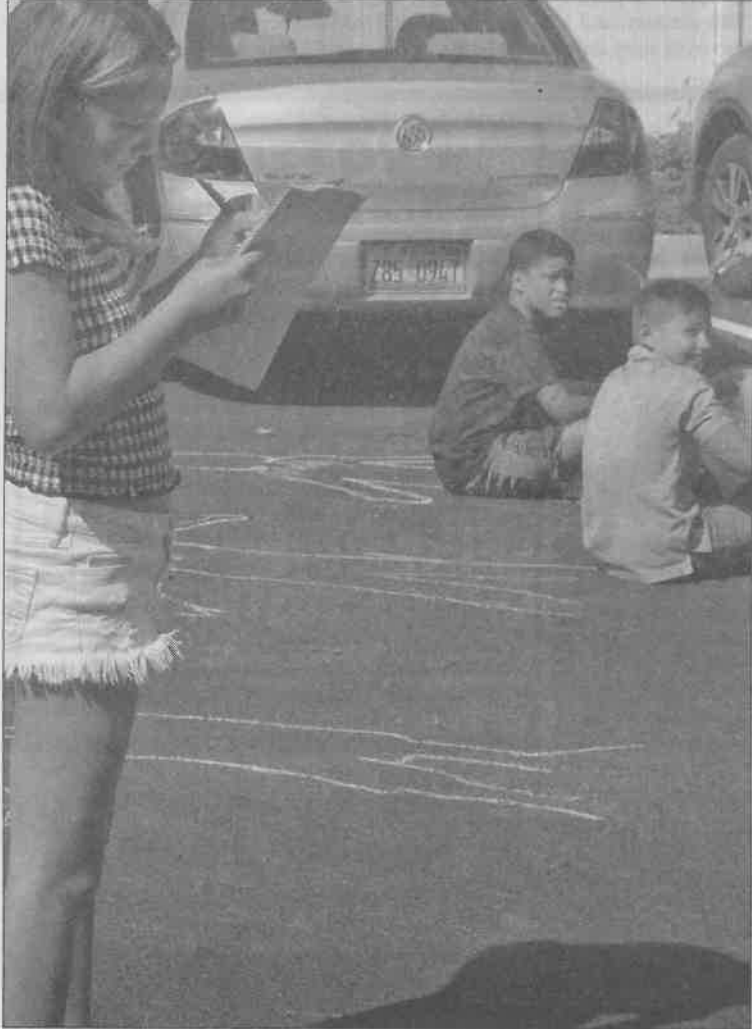


# 'Me & My Shadow' becomes a lesson for fifth graders

The fifth graders in Ms. Monreal's class at Stone School spent some time in the parking lot on Thursday, Aug. 30, learning about shadows. The students worked in teams to complete a question sheet that included items such as "Can you make your head's shadow with your hand?" "Can you make your shadow smaller?" and, "Can you hide your shadow in someone else's?" Earlier in the day, students had drawn outlines of their shadows on the asphalt surface.
