### **OLD COLONY YMCA EXEMPT EMERGENCY SITES**

Old Colony Y was chosen as one of Governor Baker's exempt emergency child care providers. Beginning Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, we will be privileged to serve the children of first responders, healthcare workers, and the other essential employees who keep our communities running.

Families in need of care are encouraged to contact each specific site, and they will help you with the enrollment process. The following sites have been approved to provide care and will be open Monday through Friday from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. All sites will accept infants, toddlers, preschoolers and school age children (with the exception of no infant care at the East Bridgewater site):

**In order to ensure a safe environment for all we will have the following policies in place:**

- Only the children and the childcare staff may enter the building – drop off and pick up of children must be made at the door
- Your child must be kept at home if:
  - Your child or someone in the home is exhibiting symptoms including fever or cough
  - If someone in your family/household is self-quarantined for monitoring of COVID-19
