iPad Agreement Contract
2018-2019**

Mission: To provide a limitless learning environment that engages and fuels the passion to learn, grow, and lead in a connected world.

Pendleton School has established guidelines and procedures to ensure that all TK-6th students demonstrate digital citizenship and meet the expectations when utilizing iPads in the classroom and at home. Please carefully read the expectations below.

1. Students will bring their iPad to school charged at least to 75% every day. Students are responsible to remember to bring their iPad to school and will **not be allowed to call home if they forget it.**
2. The Buena Park School District (BPSD) issued red iPad case must remain on the iPad at all times. Do not write your name on this case.
3. Students may bring their own earbuds or headphones if they prefer. Pendleton School and BPSD are not responsible for personal property that is lost, stolen, or damaged.
4. Students will only use apps and programs that have been installed by the district. Students may not download their own apps, music, or videos. The iPad is the property of the district and any teacher or administrator has the right to inspect it at any time.
5. Students must follow all of the rules and procedures that have been established by the classroom teacher.
6. Student must immediately report to the teacher if the iPad is not working, lost, damaged, or stolen. If the iPad is lost, stolen, or totally damaged as a result of **irresponsible** behavior, the parent may be responsible for the full replacement cost. Please see the costs below:

iPads are covered under Apple’s iCare program. With this coverage, the cost of repair (i.e. cracked screen) is \$49.00. Payment for repair is due upon receipt of the damaged iPad.

Replacement costs for iPads and iPad components are as follows:

iPad	\$321.43	Sync Cable	\$12.00
Uzbl Case	\$28.30	Power Brick	\$12.00

Please note that only original Apple and Apple-certified sync cables and power bricks will be accepted when your student returns their iPad.

A **digital citizen** is one who knows what is right and wrong, exhibits intelligent technology behavior, and makes good choices when using technology. Students will be given the following consequences in the event that rules and procedures are not followed:

- If a student receives progressive discipline resulting in 3 minor infractions, he/she will receive a classroom consequence.
- If a student commits a major infraction involving inappropriate use of the iPad (i.e. unapproved airdrop, images, email or other communication; cyberbullying; habitual minor infractions, etc.), the iPad will be kept at school for *at least* 5 school days.
