State EOC Retests

Farmersville High School will be administering the state End of Course re-test exams the week of December 3 – 7 for students who have failed to pass the EOC tests previously. The English I re-test will be Monday, December 3 and the Algebra I test will be Tuesday, December 4th. Wednesday, December 5th will be the re-test day for English II while Biology and U.S. History re-tests will be held on Thursday, December 6th. Mrs. Cooper, the counselor, sent letters home with students having to take a re-test the week after Thanksgiving.

SEMESTER EXAMS

All students will be taking semester exams on Monday, December 17 and Tuesday, December 18. Students in grades 9-11 will take semester exams in all core subjects but can be exempt from exams in electives if they meet the exemption criteria found in the student handbook on page 40. Seniors will have to take exams in Government/Economics and English. They can be exempt if they meet the criteria in other subjects.
