Governor Northam Announces Schools to Remain Closed for the Remainder of the School Year

By now you may have heard the Governor's announcement today that schools will remain closed for the remainder of the school year. We are working with the Virginia Department of Education to determine how to address this change and will be providing our families with additional information as soon as that guidance is available. The Superintendent will be briefed on Tuesday at 2:00 pm and we will provide more information by Wednesday evening, March 25.

There are particular topics that we expect to be able to share with you by Wednesday, including standard and verified credits required for graduation, GPA, grades and the continuity of instruction for all students for the rest of the school year.

We will continue with our meal distribution plan for the remainder of the school year. We realize these are trying times for everyone, and we understand you have many questions. IWCS is working tirelessly to provide answers for you and we will share that information with you through our usual channels. Again, thank you for your patience and flexibility, and as always, thank you for your support of the students, staff and community of Isle of Wight County Schools.
