Early Student Release/School Safety

For the safety of all students, AUSD mandates that anyone picking up a student during school hours **MUST** check in the main office and present a valid photo ID. Please make sure that you are dropping off and picking up your child at the designated areas and not entering school campus without checking in to the main office.

Only a parent or legal guardian who is holder of educational rights can remove a student from school. Prior approval from parent/guardian must be communicated to the school office before anyone listed on the emergency contacts can remove a student early from school.

AUSD Uniform Policy Grades K-8

District-wide mandatory uniforms are to be worn daily.

Pants/Shorts/ Skirts/Skorts/
Jumpers:

- Color: Navy blue, khaki
- Style: Fitted at the waist or elastic waist
- Fabric: Twill, cotton or cotton blend, polyester blend, corduroy; sweat materials are not acceptable. Skirts/Skorts/Jumper length must be mid-thigh (bottom of fingertips) to mid-calf

Shirts/Blouses:

- Color: Navy blue, white or school color
- Style: Polo, turtleneck, short or long sleeves
- Note: All shirts and blouses must have collars and sleeves.
