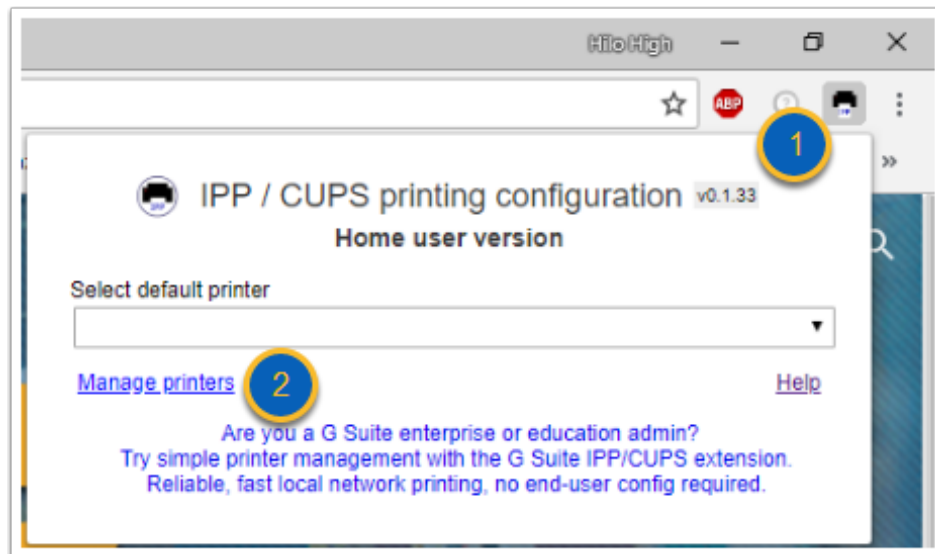


Select IPP/CUPS Icon

2. Click on Manage printer



Add Printer

1. Label Printer
2. Auto detect
3. Type in IP of Printer with an http:// first, example: <http://10.128.8.33>
 1. For the Library, https:// must be used. The IP Address for the Library is: <https://10.128.8.33>
4. Press Save

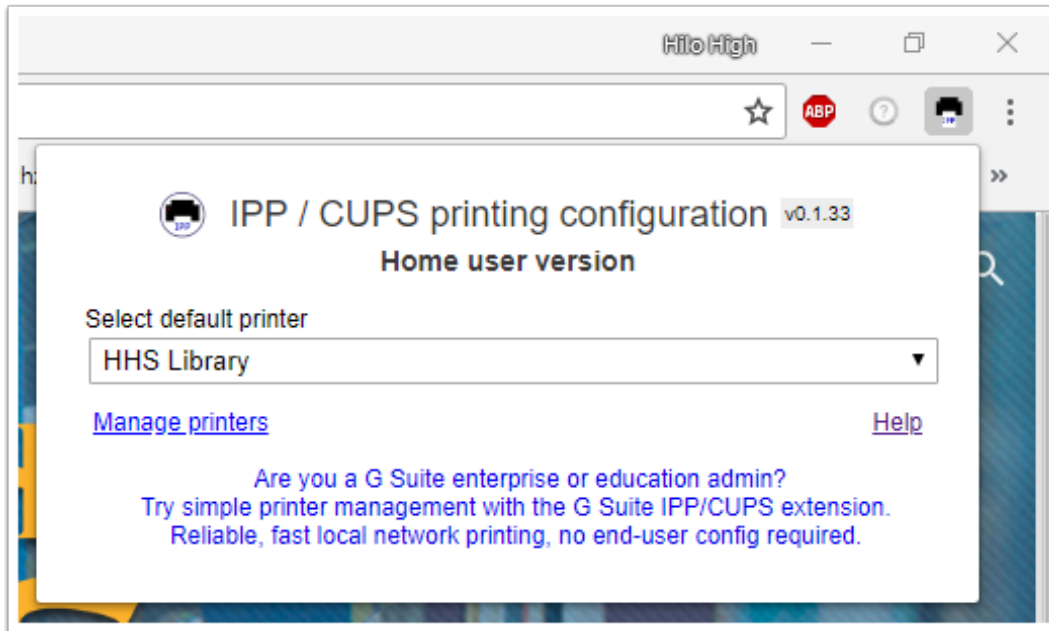

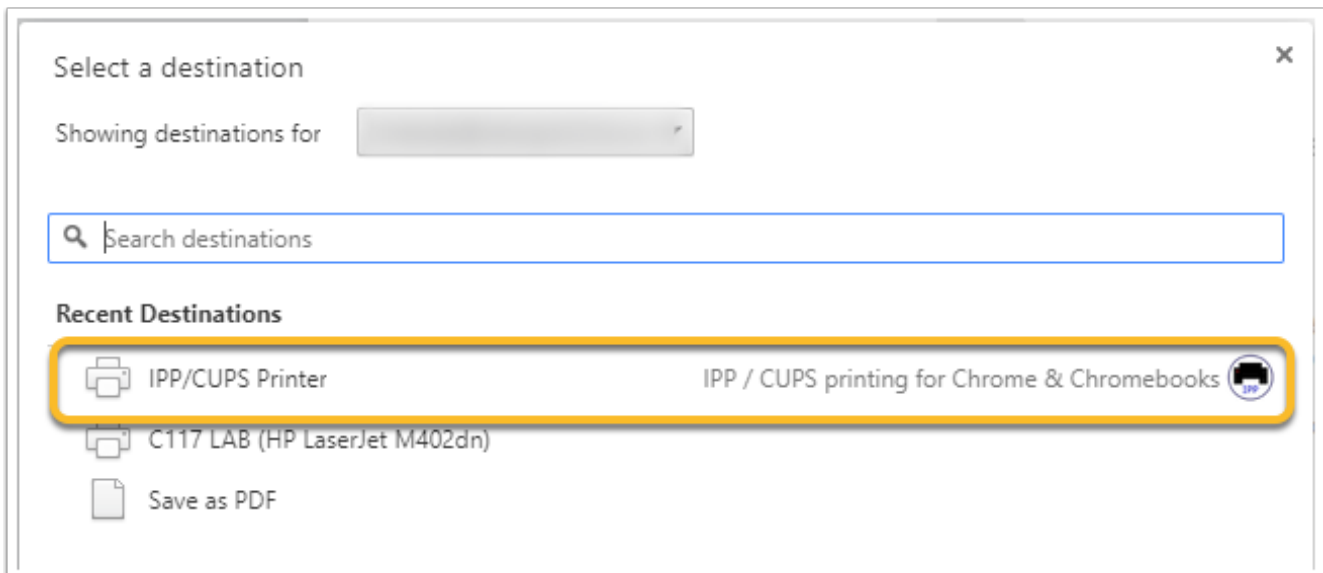
Select Default Printer
