- Knights of Columbus:** Dedicated to the principals of Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism. St. Mary Council #4196 volunteers service to our Church and community.
- Eucharistic Ministers:** Age 8th grade and older, share the Eucharist with the congregation at Mass.
- Homebound Ministry:** Adults (must be able to drive) take Communion to the homebound on a regular schedule
- Altar Servers:** Age 5th grade and older, periodic training is available.
- Lectors:** Ministers of the Word, proclaim Scripture at Mass after careful preparation through prayerful reflection. Training and workshops provided.
- Ushers:** A ministry of hospitality; greet and welcome people at Church, take up collections, usher Communion.
- St. Mary Choir:** This choir serves their liturgical role weekly At 9 am Mass on Sunday and for liturgy and special occasions.
- Family Choir:** Family Choir sings only the last Sunday of the month at 11:15 am Mass and other occasions.
- Religious Education:** Elementary (grades 1-5) need teachers & assistants.
- Youth Group:** Middle school (grades 6-8) and High School (grades 9-12) need volunteer help with weekly meetings, social outings and retreats.
- St. Vincent de Paul:** Help the less fortunate in our area with a food bank, or emergency assistance.
- Seniors Phoenix Club:** Monthly potluck on the 2nd Friday of each month for our retired parishioners September thru May.
- Coffee & Donuts:** Community gathering after occasional Sunday Masses.
- Loving Care - Funeral Luncheons:** Help is needed for calling volunteers, set - up, food prep, serving & clean up.
- Prayer Chain:** Members pray for intentions requested by phone.
- Quilting:** Get together to make quilts to give to charities.
- Women at the Well:** Enjoy a monthly event for social time, prayer and outreach.
- Family Promise:** Provides overnight housing for temporarily homeless families at Church 4 times a year. Volunteers provide meals, host, supplies, set-up and take-down.
- Guatemala Mission:** Our purpose is to facilitate monetary donations which are directed to the medical mission in our diocesan Guatemala Mission in the Diocese of Solola, Guatemala. Also conducts two fundraisers each year selling weavings from the Mission and used books and SERVV items.
- Prepares/Lambs Closet:** where families can access an emergency bundle of 10 diapers and free clothing in sizes newborn through 5.
