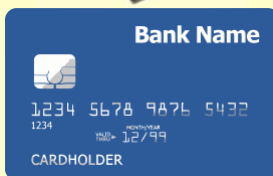

Medication

If your child takes medication while at school, please see Ms. Morey, our nurse. All medications must have a written prescription from the child's physician accompanied by the written authorization of the parent. This document will be kept on file in the office of the principal and made available to the persons authorized to administer medication or treatment. The prescription medication must be in its original container, labeled with the student's name and the exact dosage. At NO time will the school administer a dosage other than that authorized by the physician's prescription. Medications must be delivered to school by an adult. It cannot be sent with a student to school.
