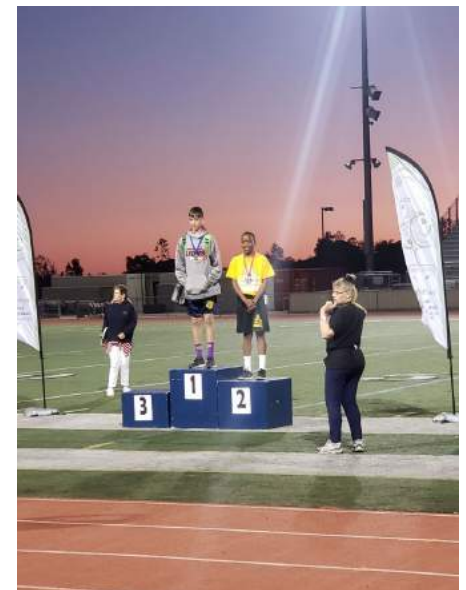
AVID Fix-It Friday!
