

SAT/ACT Registration Guide

- Be sure to write down your USERNAME and PASSWORD.
- Many students already have a SAT (College Board) account created during PSAT or AP testing. Do not create another account!
- Not all colleges require the essay. Research the colleges you intend to which you intend apply.

- Double check the date and test location. TMHS is not a test center. However, most CFISD and KISD high schools are test centers. You will find this information when you register.

Selective University Requirements

Be aware that some selective universities require Subject Tests and some allow ACT scores to take the place of this requirement for admission. Be sure to research the admission requirements for each of your intended schools. For more information about Subject Tests, go to SATSubjectTests.org.

Fee Waivers

If you are eligible for free/reduced lunch, you are eligible for 2 fee waivers for the SAT and ACT.

You will also be eligible for college application waivers if you use a testing fee waiver.

See Mrs. Phelan in the College & Career Center for a fee waiver.

College application fee-waiver forms will be distributed electronically to students with no need for counselor verification. Eligible students will access their CAFWs via their College Board online account.

Sending Official Score Reports

- Send your scores to 4 colleges for free. If you do not send them now or within 9 days of taking your test for the SAT, you will have to pay to send them later. Be smart... save \$\$\$!
- If you are planning to play a sport in college, don't forget to register with the NCAA (www.eligibilitycenter.org) and send at least one test score to 9999 (NCAA).
- If you plan to take dual credit classes, Lone Star College will require you to send an official score report.
