Also, look for more information about class participation that will be coming soon. Classes will work together to prepare some themed baskets that can be auctioned that evening.

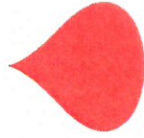
Remember, the revenue generated helps to support extra programs at our school such as Music and P.E.
