Goal #3: Improve Communication and Collaboration

Indicator: Schools will meet or exceed state accountability requirements.

Strategy #1: Formal transition meetings at student transition points.

- Transitions held between CDC and Special Education
- Transition meetings scheduled between 5th and 6th Grade special education staff as students move from elementary schools to intermediate school. Meeting include building intervention teams and administration when needed.
- Transition meetings scheduled between 8th and 9th Grade special education staff as students move from elementary schools to intermediate school. Meeting include building intervention teams and administration when needed.

Strategy #2: School District #2 Website development & other communication modes

- In Spring and Summer of 2014 the district contracted to have a new website developed with the hope of better communicating with, students, parents, community, and staff. Teachers have the ability to update their personal pages while posting information for students and parents.
- Introduce and utilize *School Way* app for parents, students, community and staff to access information via smart phones (Fall 2017)

Strategy #3: Develop post-secondary partnerships

- Concurrent Enrollment opportunities: Working with WWCC, students are able to take high school classes at GRHS and EA which also qualify as college credit at WWCC.
- Dual Enrollment opportunities: Working with WWCC, students are able to take classes through WWCC which can also count towards high school graduation credit.
- Middle College: Through expanding opportunities with WWCC some students will be able to graduate from GRHS or EA having completed year one of their progress towards an associate's degree.

Strategy #4: Develop community partnerships:

- Regularly scheduled collaborative meeting between Sweetwater County School District #2 and the Green River Parks and Recreation.
- Regular collaboration between Sweetwater County School District #2 and the Green River Police Department.
- Regular collaboration between Sweetwater County School District #2 and juvenile probation in order to assist in transition back to school.
