Mrs. Murdaugh called the meeting to order and Ms. Priester gave the invocation.

In accordance with the SC Code of Laws, 1976, Section 30-4-80 (d), as amended, the media has been notified of the time, date and place of this meeting (WBHC Radio Station and the Hampton County Guardian). In addition, the official agenda has been posted at the District Office.

Mrs. Murdaugh welcomed the media and public to the board meeting. There was no media present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mrs. Murdaugh.

Ms. Priester made a motion, which was properly seconded by Mr. Jenkins, to enter into executive session to discuss a student discipline matter, personnel matter, and a contractual matter. The motion passed unanimously.

The Board voted to convene in Open Session.

Open Session

Mrs. Gooding made a motion, which was properly seconded by Ms. Priester, to accept Dr. McTeer's recommendation to award the contract for grounds and maintenance at North District Middle School and the District Office to Horizon Landscaping and Irrigation and the grounds and maintenance at Wade Hampton High School to Southern Green. The motion passed unanimously.

The media will be notified of our Veterans being recognized at the last home game at Wade Hampton.

Dr. McTeer stated that band parents had requested that the band be allowed to leave three football games at half time. Dr. McTeer denied the request for the Hilton Head and Barnwell games and approved the request for the Silver Bluff game.

Architect, Danny Shelley will discuss with the contractor about the gable at the field house and concession stand and report back to Dr. McTeer.

The Zoning Committee is meeting tonight concerning a rezoning plan that would permit the establishment of a half-way house near Hampton Elementary School. Dr. McTeer wrote a letter to the committee in opposition to the rezoning plan.

Mrs. Gooding made a motion, which was properly seconded by Ms. Priester, to adjourn. The motion passed unanimously.
