



## Electronic Resources Agreement

### GUARDIAN OPT-OUT PROTOCOL FOR PUBLICATION

Mead School District shares directory information to third parties that would not generally be considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if disclosed. Directory information includes – student work and individual student photographs, with names, to showcase student accomplishments, classroom activities and school events in district media, public news outlets and for third party educational usage. The complete definition of directory information is provided below.

**If you do not want Mead School District to disclose the types of information designated below as directory information from your child’s education records and/or you wish to prohibit your student’s photo from being used in ways specified above without your prior written consent, you must notify the school your child attends in writing, designating *photos only, information only or both*, by October 2 of the current school year. If you choose to have your child’s information withheld be aware that electronic learning platforms like those described below will be unavailable to your child.**

*Directory information* means information contained in an education record of a student that would not generally be considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if disclosed. This description is informed by federal law 20 U.S.C. 1232g(a)(5)(A)).

- (a) *Directory information includes, but is not limited to, the student’s name; address; telephone listing; electronic mail address; photograph; date and place of birth; major field of study; grade level; enrollment status (e.g., undergraduate or graduate, full-time or part-time); dates of attendance; participation in officially recognized activities and sports; weight and height of members of athletic teams; degrees, honors, and awards received; and the most recent educational agency or institution attended.*
- (b) *Directory information does not include a student’s –*
  - 1. *Social Security number; or*
  - 2. *Student identification (ID) number, except as provided in paragraph (c) of this definition.*
- (c) *In accordance with paragraphs (a) and (b) of this definition, directory information includes –*
  - 1. *A student ID number, user ID, or other unique personal identifier used by a student for purposes of accessing or communication in electronic systems, but only if the identifier cannot be used to gain access to education records except when used in conjunction with one or more factors that authenticate the user’s identity, such as personal identification number (PIN), password or other factor known or possessed only by the authorized user; and*
  - 2. *A student ID number or other unique personal identifier that is displayed on a student ID badge, but only if the identifier cannot be used to gain access to education records except when used in conjunction with one or more factors that authenticate the user’s identity, such as PIN, password, or other factor known or possessed only by the authorized user.*
