Dear 8th Grade Parents and Students:

We're going to Disneyland! Please read what follows carefully for details regarding this upcoming event. Be sure to act quickly and purchase your tickets. **If you have any questions, please feel free to contact Mr. Jurafsky at 798-8616 or rjurafsky@rbusd.org (e-mail is best).** We are looking forward to a fun and rewarding promotion activity.

Ticket Sales: Tickets are \$105 for each student; scholarships are available. Students with a Disneyland Park Pass will pay a transportation fee of \$25.

This year, there are three payment options: credit card, electronic check, or cash. **No refunds will be granted for any reason.**

For those choosing to pay by credit or electronic check, the online permission slip and payment processing is **DUE NO LATER THAN WEDNESDAY, MAY 22**. The form can be accessed at: <https://forms.gle/DqFvBn65eEEDaFJY8>

For those paying by cash, please bring the completed permission slip (attached) and funds to the **PTSA Desk in the Parras Library** as follows:

- **Wednesday, May 22 at lunch** (11:45 a.m. – 12:15 p.m.)
- **Thursday, May 23 at lunch** (12:20 p.m. – 12:50 p.m.)

Transportation: Students must ride the bus both to and from Disneyland, **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS**. **Buses will leave Parras at 7:00 a.m.** and depart from Disneyland at 6:15 p.m., returning to Parras at approximately 7:30 p.m. *Any student not present at departure time will be required to be picked up by a parent and will face disciplinary action at school.*

Parents, please arrive at Parras promptly at 7:30 p.m. to pick up your child, unless you have indicated on the permission slip that s/he is allowed to walk home. We discourage anyone from walking home alone more than a few blocks due to the late hour.

Food/Beverage: **This is not included in the ticket price.** Students are encouraged to eat a hearty breakfast and bring ample money for purchase of lunch while at Disneyland.

Behavior/Supervision: It is a privilege to attend this event; therefore, students are expected to be on their best behavior throughout the day. Students whose prior behavior and/or performance requires discipline at school may be excluded from the trip. Should a student misbehave while on this trip, the student will be required to call his/her parents to be picked up at Disneyland; additional consequences will be enforced upon our return to school.

Students will be allowed to freely roam the park, but may **not** explore California Adventure or Downtown Disney. In the case of illness or emergency, Parras staff will be on duty just outside the Disneyland First Aid Station at all times during our trip.

Dress Code: Students should dress as they would for a regular school day. As usual, extreme make-up, baggy pants, revealing clothing, unsafe shoes, etc. will **not** be permitted. Full-sized backpacks are discouraged; small backpacks, “fanny” packs, or purses are more appropriate. Due to anticipated weather conditions, sun-block is strongly encouraged for everyone; hats that fit school parameters may also be worn. **Students arriving at school in inappropriate attire will be excluded from the Disneyland trip and no refunds will be given.**
