## Course Descriptions

**\*All academic courses are one week in length.**

### Summer Reading Section #100

If you enjoy reading and discussing books as a class rather than by yourself over the summer, this is the class for you. This course covers books on the summer reading list and students do activities and games to ensure comprehension.

### Creative Writing Section #200

Students will tap into their creative side in this fun and engaging class. Students will work weekly to create, revise, and publish short stories.

### Escape Room Logic Section #300

Students will enjoy working together in small groups to tackle fun logic problems and games.

### Math/Summer Solutions 3-5 Section #101

This 1-hour course will cover the material in the *Summer Solutions* workbook and review math at each grade level. Fun, math-based activities will also be incorporated such as cooking, sewing, Google Slides, STEAM, and more.

### Reading Comprehension K-5 Section #201

This course is 1-hour and will cover reading and comprehension skills at each grade level. Summer Themed Kahoot games will also be incorporated.

### Coding/ Robotics K-5 Section #301

This one-hour course will allow students to practice coding while incorporating our wonderful “Dash” robots. Other STEAM projects will also be integrated into the curriculum.

### Study Skills/ Test Prep 6-8 Section #105

Students in grades 6-8 will review study and note-taking skills as well as how to prepare for tests.

### Public Speaking Section #205

Students in grades 6-8 will have the opportunity to work on speech writing as well as presentations in a fun and interactive way.

### Study Skills K-5 Section #305

Students in grades K-5 will review study skills as well as how to prepare for tests.

### Morning Daycare (TK-8) Section #106, 206, 306

Morning Day Camp is available for period-long sessions. There will be fun daily activities and events built into the program.

### **Art Grades 3-5 #107**

Art students will enjoy a trip around the world ticket, plus one for home, without packing their bags! Each week a different culture will be explored through art. We will creatively use clays, paints, beads, glues and grouts to create sculptures, paintings, jewelry and mosaics. Different techniques will be taught to give each child a fun way to express themselves uniquely through art. ### **Reading in Motion Comprehension Section #108**

Students will work on mastering their reading comprehension skills using kinesthetic techniques that keep the students moving and engaged.

### **Reading in Motion Phonics Section #208**

Students will work on mastering their phonics skills using kinesthetic techniques that keep the students moving and engaged.

### **Hands-on Science Section #308**

This course will allow all of our future scientists and engineers to complete different hand-on STEAM science projects and Mystery Science experiments each day.

### **Summer Spanish 3-5 #209**

This one hour course will teach basic Spanish Vocabulary and Greetings through music, engaging activities, and games. It will also include learning about customs and traditions in Spanish Speaking Countries. The last day of the course we will prepare a meal and take part in a FIESTA!

### **Summer Spanish K-2 #309**

This one hour course offers Spanish for students using songs, stories, and engaging activities which motivates children to play and have fun while learning the language. It will also offer craft activities and cooking to help the students develop an interest in various Spanish Speaking Countries.

### **Math Summer Solutions K-2 Section #110**

This 1-hour course will cover the material in the *Summer Solutions* workbook and review math at each grade level. Fun, math-based activities will also be incorporated.

### **Math Summer Solutions 6-8 Section #210**

This 1-hour course will cover the material in the *Summer Solutions* workbook and review math at each grade level. Fun, math-based activities will also be incorporated.

### **Cooking for Kids K-5 Section #111**

Aspiring chefs will have the opportunity to create culinary masterpieces in this beginning cooking course. Students will learn new recipes and enjoy wonderful food each day!

### **Creative Kids Playhouse (July 15-19) 12:00 – 4:30 pm Section #400**

Creative Kids Playhouse is offering a week-long ½ day afternoon drama camp for students ages 6-13. Students will perform a one act musical of the Jack and the Beanstalk at the end of the week. Cost is \$200.

**Athletic Camps (June 17-21, June 24 - 28 and August 12 - 15) 8:30 am – 12:00 pm -** Athletic Camps focus on fundamental skill development, sportsmanship, and strategies of the game. Students have an opportunity to explore Volleyball, Basketball, and Flag Football, develop sport specific skills and build team work. Our camps are great way to exercise, meet new teammates, and prepare for the upcoming season or discover a new interest. Day care is available after the Athletic Camps.

## **MBS Summer School Program Information**

### **Dress Code:**

Summer school attire includes appropriate clothing in the following fashion:

- jeans, pants, shorts (as long as the fingers on an extended arm)
- t-shirts, button-down shirts, blouses, sweatshirts (shoulders must be covered)
- skirts, dresses (appropriate length)

The following are not permitted at Mission Basilica School on free dress days:

- baggy or oversized clothing
- tight or revealing clothing
- torn/ripped clothing
- tank tops, spaghetti strap tops, halter tops, or tops that show a bare midriff
- overalls
- sweats
- message t-shirts or sweatshirts
- opened-toed shoes
- extreme hairstyles or hair dyes/colors/bleaches
- hoop, dangle, or large earrings
- colored nail polish
- make-up
- colored lip gloss or lipstick
- watches with beeping devices or other sounds

### **Snack/Passing Periods:**

Students may bring a snack that can be eaten between any of the passing periods. We simply ask that these snacks not include any peanuts or peanut products as we will enroll many students who have peanut allergies. The students will eat their snacks at the lunch tables. Eating in the hallways, restrooms, etc. will not be permitted. Water bottles are permitted in the classrooms.

### **Student Arrival (Please arrive 10 minutes before class starts):**

All Preschool students (Ages 2-5) must be dropped off and signed in at their classrooms (classrooms will be announced at a later time). All TK-8 students must be dropped off at their classroom.

### **\*Mid-Day Arrival:**

*Arrival at 9:45am, 11:00am, or 12:30pm*

Students who arrive mid-day should follow the same procedures as detailed above. Drivers, please be aware that mid-day arrival and dismissal run simultaneously, so please exercise caution when exiting from parking spaces.

### **\*Mid-Day Student Dismissal (Periods 2 or 3):**

If you are picking up a student or students **at the end of periods 1 or 2**, please pick them up from the classroom or gym (for sports).

**Student Dismissal: *Regular Dismissal (End of Period 3) 12:00-12:15pm***

Students in grades TK-8 will wait on the tile at 12:00 pm for dismissal. Preschool students (Ages 2-5) must be signed out in their classroom.

**Confirmation of Registration:**

Confirmation of registration will be in the form of your processed/cancelled check. You will be notified if the classes you have selected are filled. Please provide a daytime phone number and email address on your registration form.

**Courses:**

***Students should be enrolled in courses for their grade in the Fall of the 2019-2020 school year.*** For example, a student who just completed 1<sup>st</sup> grade should be enrolled in a class for their incoming grade (2<sup>nd</sup> grade) which is marked as “2” in our descriptions.
