Parents:

Each student will choose and read a non-fiction book on their level. After reading make a list of 5 facts you learned from the text. You will use this information to create a mobile book report. The completed project will be due the first week we return to school. It will be counted for a literacy grade.

Materials

- Plastic or metal clothes hanger
- 7 strings of yarn of different lengths
- Hole punch
- Sturdy paper squares, circles, rectangles (cardstock is best)

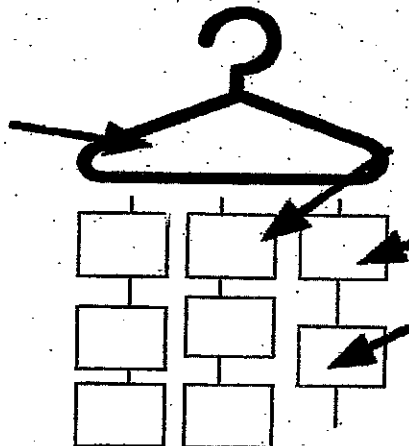


Instructions

1. On card number 1, write the title of the book on one side of the card and the authors name on the other side. Be creative with your title.
2. For cards 2,3,4,5,6 write one fact you learned from the book one side of the card and draw an illustration of it on the other side of the card. You must use complete sentences.
3. On card number 7, write your name on one side of the card and a sentence or two telling what you thought of the book on the back of the card. Be sure I can see your name.
4. Use a hole punch to punch one hole at the top of each card.
5. Tie one side of each of yarn to the bottom of the hanger, spacing them evenly.
6. Take one card and tie it to the bottom end of one string. Continue with the rest of the cards.
7. Decorate your "hanger" to match the topic of your book.

• Title, author, picture of the cover, students name

• 3 facts you learned from the story on front and picture on back.



• 3 vocabulary words from the book and definition






• Did you like the book why or why not?


• Would you recommend this book to others?


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


