

Policy:

The Board of Directors shall adopt long-term goals for achieving the school's overall vision as well as clear performance standards and benchmarks. Goals shall be limited so as to be reasonably achievable within established timelines.

The Executive Director may establish short-term, interim objectives and comprehensive plans to ensure adequate, regular progress toward the school's long-term goals.

The school's long term goals are to:

1. Maintain safe, productive and orderly schools which promote learning.
2. Provide appropriate instruction to meet the varied academic and career goals of individual student needs.
3. Strive to lead all students towards actualization of their full potential in essential areas of knowledge and ability.
4. Provide for the specialized needs of identified students.
5. Develop each student's self-respect, respect for others, appreciation for diversity and sense of personal responsibility.
6. Provide time and resources for collaboration, planning, and professional development for staff.
7. Maintain fiscal integrity for the school.
8. Improve the organization, management and decision-making structure, and capabilities of the school to better support the education of students.
9. Employ technology in ways that enhance learning, teaching and basic operations.
10. Provide and maintain facilities to meet the needs of present and future students.
11. Maintain positive relations with parents/guardians and the community, emphasizing communication with, and inviting participation in, the schools.
12. Collaborate with other public agencies and private organizations to ensure that children's physical, social, and emotional needs are adequately assured.

13. Share accountability with students for reaching their full potential achievement.
