McKinney-Vento Homeless Education
Procedure for the Identification of Homeless Children & Youth

The PSUSD Home Liaison will identify students experiencing homelessness during enrollment by ensuring the following:

- Family will inform school district to qualify as we provide services to all students
- Liaison will follow-up with family to obtain additional information, if needed.
- Liaison will post the Educational Rights of Homeless Students Posters at enrollment counters.
- Liaison will include the Educational Rights of Homeless Students in the enrollment packet.
- Due to difference in homeless definition between Native American cultural view of homelessness and ADE (multi-generational, multi-family households), PSUSD will provide services for all students that attend PSUSD and provide instructional supplies free of charge from paper, pencils, crayons, school supplies, and non-instructional supplies such as hygiene products, breakfast, lunch, field trip funds, etc.
- As the homeless shelter is next door, transportation is walking distance of only a few feet from school grounds, therefore transportation does not apply.

The PSUSD Home Liaison will identify students experiencing homelessness during the academic year by ensuring the following:

- Liaison will train all staff (including new staff throughout school year) who have interaction with students including the following:
 - Bus Drivers (if we have drivers)
 - Teachers
 - Cafeteria Workers
 - Front Office Staff
 - Custodian,
 - business office staff
- Liaison will provide the Educational Rights of Homeless Students two additional times during the academic year in one or more of the following means **(in schools and in the community)**:
 - Pamphlets posted in the front doorway and in the local post office
 - Student Packets
 - Website
