Dear Gorman Families and Employees,

On March 14, 2020, the Board of Directors for Gorman Learning Charter Network declared a State of Emergency and voted to close all physical resource centers for two (2) weeks effective Monday, March 16th, 2020. The Board also voted to give Executive Director, Denice Burchett, authority to extend the closure for an additional two (2) weeks if it is in the best interest of Gorman families and employees.

Gorman families are to continue all of their independent study coursework at home. Personalized Learning Teachers (PLT) will continue to be in contact with families to gather LP work and assign new coursework. The resource centers are working to create virtual and online workshops that students who participate in resource center workshops can participate virtually. The Virtual Resource Center will continue to hold workshops at their regular times. Online classes through Gorman vendors are still available and should be attended at their normal times.

If you have questions about the coursework or assignments that will be due during this time, please consult with your PLT.

All student events, family events, and CAASPP camps will be postponed during the resource center closure. We will be updating information on events through ParentSquare, our Facebook page, our website, PLTs, and email.

All employees should report back for work the week of March 16th, 2020 where they will be given further guidance.

As new information becomes available we will be posting updates. Please check our information outlets for updates. For any questions regarding your student's coursework, please contact your PLTs. We hope all our families will continue to take preventative action for their own health and welfare. We will continue to provide sanitary facilities for our employees to work in.
