SUBJECT: Compliance with AHERA Management Plan  
Annual Notification Requirement

This written annual notification is required by the AHERA regulation. On October 22, 1986, President Reagan signed into law the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), which required the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to promulgate the final rules for asbestos management by October 17, 1987. The final rules required that all public and private schools develop a new Asbestos Management Plan and submit it to Governor McWherter or his designee by May 9, 1989. We are pleased to inform you that the Moore County Schools have complied with all aspects of this regulation.

The Moore County Management Plan, which includes previous asbestos abatement projects, six months surveillance reports, the locations and condition of the remaining asbestos-containing materials in our buildings, as well as the recommended response action chosen for each, is available for your review at the following locations:
