- 🐾 **Safety procedures** Our school doors open at 7:30 a.m. for you to drop off your child/ren to the cafeteria. When dropping off and picking up, pull all the way forward in the drop off lane. Vehicles are not to be left unattended in the drop off/loading zone at any time and they should not block access to/from the designated disabled spaces. Refrain from blocking neighborhood drive ways during pick up. Please note: the bus loading/drop off zone on Alluvial is for buses only.
 - *Drop off for grades 1-6:* Students only in grades 1-6 enter through the main doors
 - *Kindergarten and transitional kindergarten:* students only will enter through the blue side gate closest to Alluvial (within our parking lot).
 - *Pick up:* All grades are walked with their class to the front of the school where parents/guardians will pick them up.
- 🐾 **Sibling pick up** For safety reasons, middle & high school students need to wait on Polk or Alluvial for the dismissal bell to pick up siblings.

 - The bus loading/drop off zone on Alluvial is for buses only.
