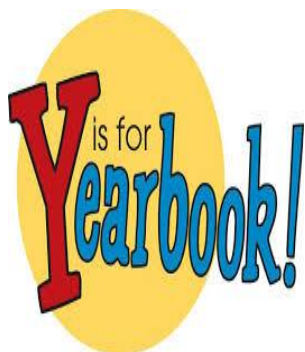

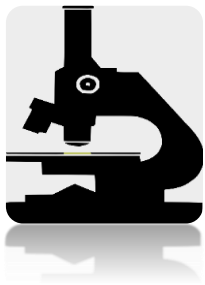

- ✓ Submit college applications with January deadlines.
- ✓ You should begin receiving a response by this time of you applied for early decision. If accepted, see what deposits are required for tuition and housing. Plan to attend an orientation session at your college.
