BART Enrolling Students for 2013-2014 School Year

Some Seats are Available for 2012-2013 School Year

Students interested in attending BART in grades 6 through 9 for the 2013-2014 school year can apply by December 10 at 12noon to ensure a spot in the school. Students interested in transferring to BART for the 2012-2013 school year may apply at any time: 14 seats are available in 6th grade, 5 seats are available in 7th grade, 20 seats are available in 8th grade and 2 seats are available in the 9th grade for the 2012-2013 school year. (No students will be accepted into grades 10, 11 or 12.)

Transportation is available for students in Adams, Cheshire, Clarksburg, Florida, Hancock, Lanesborough, North Adams, Pittsfield, Savoy and Williamstown.
