Dear Parents,

It is the policy of Beaumont Unified School District that each student riding the school bus must obtain a bus pass. Effective Monday, August 7th, the Transportation Department will **require all students** riding the bus to have a bus pass in their possession. Please be sure that your child has a bus pass while boarding the bus at their designated bus stop on a daily basis. This is for the safety of your children.

In the event that your child does not have a bus pass, transportation will be denied. You may obtain a bus pass from the Enrollment Center. If it is necessary to replace a lost bus pass, you may obtain a duplicate bus pass for \$5.00.
