

Announcements for Wednesday, May 15, 2019

1. Attention juniors and seniors, JHS is having a Student Hiring Fair on **TODAY, May 15** from 11:30-1:20. Seniors who will attend the Hiring fair will be released at 11:30 a.m. to attend. Juniors and seniors will have the option to attend during Pow-Wow. Local Employers will setup in the Upper Gym where students will have the opportunity to speak to employers and apply for summer or part-time jobs. For more information please see Mr. Boyd or Mrs. Stephens. Juniors and seniors who plan to attend the Student Hiring fair on must be in professional dress or school dress code.
