**Registration enrollment for CCUSD Students will begin on March 1st.** Open enrollment begins **March 18<sup>th</sup> 2019 to the public.** Our Camps are based upon the grade your child has recently completed. Camps are designed as weekly sessions with different exciting enrichment activities. The weekly fee is \$200 with a onetime registration fee of \$50.00. Payments must be made two weeks prior to your child attending camp. A \$50.00 deposit is also required for each week you select at the time of enrollment.

**A discount of \$200 is given if all 9 weeks are paid by June 1<sup>st</sup>.**

## Field Trips:

All field trips are included with your fee. Trips depart from and return to Farragut Elementary. Due to safety and program guidelines, children **cannot** be taken to and/or picked up from the field trip site.

## Kids Quest (TK/ Kindergarten)

At Kids Quest, students will take a trip around the seven continents. Students will learn about the various languages, arts, animals and games that kids play around the world. Activities are designed to educate through play and hands on crafts. Whether it is forming Native American tribal art, creating a Mancala board from Africa or making a Korean Number chart, students will gain an understanding of the cultures and wonders that the world has to offer.

## Camp Creation (1<sup>st</sup> Grade)
