Hampton One students can now receive dental services within the school district this year at the **Smiles for a Lifetime Dental Center** at no cost to parents. With a generous grant from the Charlotte, N.C.-based **Duke Endowment**, the nonprofit health care network **Welvista** has established a **Smiles for a Lifetime Dental Center**. The center is housed on the campus of **Varnville Elementary School**. Students from all Hampton One schools now have the opportunity to receive cleaning, sealants, and / or restorative treatments.
