Student Section:

Beachy Gate Exit with "Home" Period: All students with a "Home" period 3 or 4 must exit campus through the Beachy Gate only.

Hall Pass and Restroom Policy: Students are not allowed out of class the first and last 20 minutes of each period.

The restrooms in the Gym will be open after school. The restrooms located in the middle of each B building floor will be open during passing period only. The restrooms adjacent to the Mustang Theatre will be open during class time.

School Rules/Policies: The Dress Code, Electronic Device Confiscation rules and all other policies will be enforced immediately upon entering our campus.

Advisory and Lunch Dismissal: To minimize the overcrowding of stairwells - all 9th and 12th grade students enter through the side stairwells of the B building after lunch. Additionally, all 10th and 11th grade students exit to the lunch area through the center stairwell of the B building only.
