

Bay Head School- Tardiness Policy (5240)

Prompt arrival at school is expected of all pupils. Later arrivals disrupt class and cause loss of instructional time. All children are given a five-minute grace period from 8:00 a.m. - 8:05a.m. Any child, who arrives at school after 8:05 a.m., is considered tardy.

Grades Kindergarten - Two

Kindergarten - Second Grades - No detentions assigned

First through third late - phone contact with parent

Fourth late - parent receives a letter

Fifth late - parent receives a letter and conference is held with guidance counselor and Principal/Superintendent

Grades Three - Eight

First through third late - phone contact with parent

Fourth late - parent receives a letter

Fifth late - parent receives a letter and conference is held with guidance counselor and Principal/Superintendent

Sixth through seventh late - twenty minute detention after parent notification

Eight through tenth late - thirty minute detention after parent notification

Tenth late - Conference is held with guidance counselor and Principal/Superintendent

Eleventh through fifteenth late - two thirty minute detentions on consecutive days after parent notification
