

Boil Water Advisory impacts several Clio schools

The City of Clio issued a boil water advisory Tuesday for its entire system following a water main break. That system serves Carter Middle School, Clio Area High School, Clio Community High School, Clio Early Elementary, and the Clio Schools Administration Building.

As a result, the district is shutting down ALL drinking fountains in those buildings and our staff is delivering bottled water to those buildings. In addition, the firm that tests our water will be onsite this morning to conduct tests.

The break occurred when a private contractor struck a water line near Griffes and Railway streets, which led to a loss of pressure in the city's entire system. That drop in pressure can allow bacteria to enter and contaminate the entire system, prompting the city to issue the boil water advisory.

Crews were hoping to restore pressure Tuesday evening and once it is back up two water samples taken 24 hours apart must pass tests for bacteria before the advisory is lifted.

Once again, the safety of our students and staff is our number one priority and we will continue to provide the bottled water, continuously monitor the situation, and provide updates as needed.
