If you are the parent of an 8th grader and are interested in your son or daughter

attending Cristo Rey/St. Martin High School, the admissions director from CRSM will be here to discuss admission requirements and the application process, that has changed, and early admission.

During the summer, our school was cleaned and painted, new Chrome books were purchased for the upper grades and iPads for each of the classrooms in each of the K-4 classrooms. New books, gym equipment and Science material will also be available to our students this year.

We look forward to offering Parent Education preK-8 activities each month again this year on topics of interest and helpful to you and your student.

Some important reminders:

- Please be sure our student's physical (Pre K, K, 6), dental (Pre K, K, 2, 6), and vision (new students) exams are up to date and on file at the school.
- Students are to be in uniform everyday except on special out of uniform days. The basic uniform is navy slacks (boys and girls), navy shorts (boys and girls), white polo shirt (boys and girls), white blouse (girls), white dress shirt (boys), blue plaid jumper K – 4th, blue plaid skirt 5th – 8th (girls-available from Dennis Uniform), black or navy ankle length leggings under the skirt, gray pullover or cardigan sweater boys and girls), black shoes (boys and girls). P.E. uniform is a gray short -sleeved MBTA t-shirt, black or navy athletic shorts or pants, gym shoes.
- All **NEW 6th** grade students are **required** to attend an Orientation Day on **Wednesday, August 15th from 10 a.m. -11 a.m.** beginning in the cafeteria.
- All **8th** graders are **required** to attend a meeting on **Tuesday, August 14th from 11-12 noon** in the school cafeteria.
- Parents and students are welcome to come to school on **Wednesday, August 15 from 10 a.m.- 1 p.m.** to meet your new teacher and bring your supplies.
- If you are interested in volunteering to attend field trips, the Archdiocese requires that all adults complete Virtus training and agree to a background check. Please go to the www.virtus.org website for training dates, in English or Spanish, that are being held in the area.
- Please join us on Wednesday mornings at 7:30 a.m. for our school mass. It is a time we come together as a school community to pray and worship and give thanks for the many blessings God has given to us. A different grade is responsible for the reading and prayer petitions, and our students are altar servers. Please join us in praising God!
- PLEASE continue to have your child read every day and tell YOU what he or she read about. Students in grades 3-8th need to **memorize** the multiplication tables up to at least **12** so practice, practice, and PRACTICE!
