



Forest Grove High School Athletic Hall of Fame Nomination Form

The Forest Grove High School Athletic Hall of Fame is the highest honor bestowed by the Forest Grove High School Athletic Department. The Forest Grove High School Athletic Hall of Fame honors former FGHS student-athletes, coaches, teams and special contributors whose accomplishments have brought prestige and honor to the Forest Grove High School Athletic Department. All nominees to the Hall of Fame must be individuals of high moral character, with outstanding leadership qualities and must be held in high esteem by their colleagues, coaches and athletes.

All nominations must fit the criteria of one of the five categories below. All nominations must include detailed supporting information, which could include newspaper clippings, proof of awards, letters of support from others, etc. If assistance is needed in compiling information about a nominee's career, they should contact the Forest Grove High School Athletic Office before the nomination is submitted.

Nominations for the Forest Grove High School Athletic Hall of Fame must be received by May 15th. The Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony is held in conjunction with a home basketball game in early Dec.

CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION

ATHLETE:

- Must be a graduate of Forest Grove High School.
- Must have received recognition for exceptional athletic performance (such as all-league all-state or all-American honors, league, or state championships). Athletes are not eligible for nomination until ten years after graduation.

Nominating information for athletes should include: high school playing record, league/state championship participation and place finishes, state honors obtained, achievements and athletic participation since graduation and a biographical sketch.

COACH:

- Must uphold the ideals and philosophies of Forest Grove High School athletics while striving to serve the best interests of high school athletics. While winning championships might be a factor, the primary concern is a person's effect upon the student-athletes and fellow coaches he/she has influenced.
- Must have served as a coach at Forest Grove High School for five years or more. Coaches are not eligible for nomination until ten years out of coaching position.
- Must have compiled a significant number of wins or produced a high winning percentage relative to the sports history.

Nomination information for coaches should include: sports coached (with win/loss records), state championships competed in by that coach's teams (with years and place finishes), league, district and state championships won by nominee's teams (with years), league/state honors received, committees or associations served and a biographical sketch.

TEAM:

- Must be a team that accomplished high ranking or high placing in league and state competition (i.e. state tournament appearances, state placing).
- Should have won one or multiple league championships.
- Teams should have brought prestige to Forest Grove High School in their actions in and out of the athletic arena. Teams are not eligible for nomination until 10 years following winning season.

Nomination information for teams should include: sport, year and head coach's name; names of all athletes on team, names of all assistant coaches, league championship, state championship participation, place finishes and a season summary.

MERITORIOUS SERVICE:

- Must exhibit a dedication and loyalty to high school athletics at Forest Grove High School.
- Their work must have made a concrete and lasting contribution to the welfare of the Forest Grove High School Athletic Department.

Nomination information for meritorious service should include: relationship to the FGHS athletic program, contributions to the athletic program, years or service to Forest Grove High School (if an employee), contributions to state or national organizations, league or OSAA, honors received and specific reasons for nomination.

HONORARY:

This category is reserved for persons who do not meet the complete criteria in any of the above nomination categories but who, in the determination of the committee, are of high enough merit and quality to warrant induction into the Hall of Fame. Induction as an Honorary member must be approved unanimously by the committee.

This page should include such information as statistics, individual and team athletic accomplishments, academic and athletic honors, national ranking and significant accomplishments or achievements, directly related to their relationship with the Forest Grove High School athletic department. For the team category, please list names of all team members, coaches and assistant coaches.

In addition, the nomination should include other forms of supporting information such as letters of support from coaches, teammates or opponents, newspaper clippings, stats sheets, verification of awards, etc.

Nomination forms not accompanied by a supporting statement may not be considered or sent back to the nominating party for additional information. If you need assistance obtaining information, the athletic office may be of some assistance.
