Scope of Work:

- **New construction:**
 - 38 classrooms and support spaces
 - Administration building
 - Library
 - Auditorium
 - Gymnasium
 - Cafeteria, lunch shelter and student store
 - Maintenance and operations building
 - Basketball courts, tennis courts and softball
- **Modernization:**
 - Existing buildings will be upgraded with new exterior and interior paint, window blinds and white boards.
 - Existing classroom buildings to remain will be upgraded with new roofing systems.
- **Site wide improvements:**
 - Upgrades to the site infrastructure and utilities, and various site-wide upgrades to comply with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act will also be undertaken.
