What is the Purpose of Title I?

Required by Section 1118(c)(1)

Convene an annual meeting at a convenient time to which all parents of participating children shall be invited and encouraged to attend to inform parents of their school's participation under this part and to explain the requirements of this part, and the right of the parents involved.

Title I Program Purpose

Provide supplemental resources to improve instruction in high poverty schools to ensure all students meet state standards.

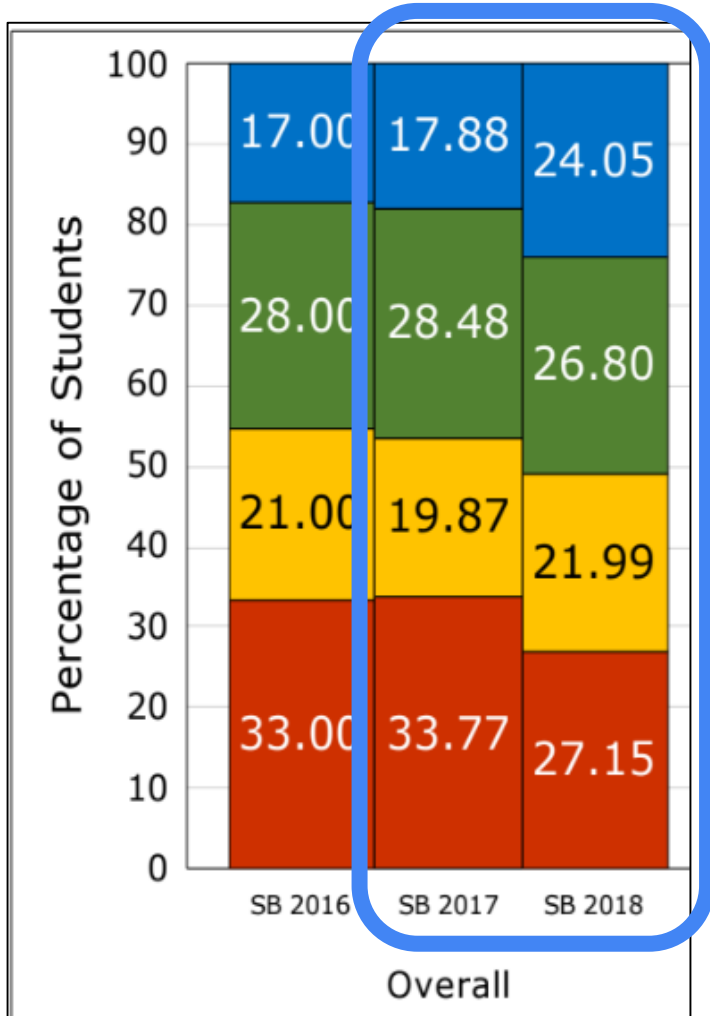


One of our 2017-2018 LANGUAGE ARTS goals:

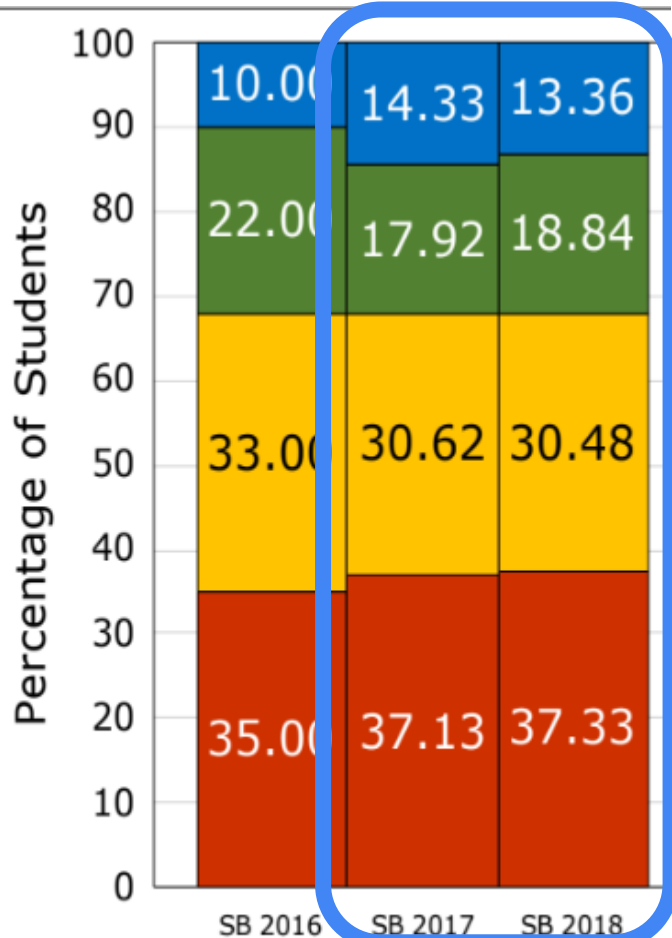


One of our 2017-2018 Math goals:

- 2018: 32.20%

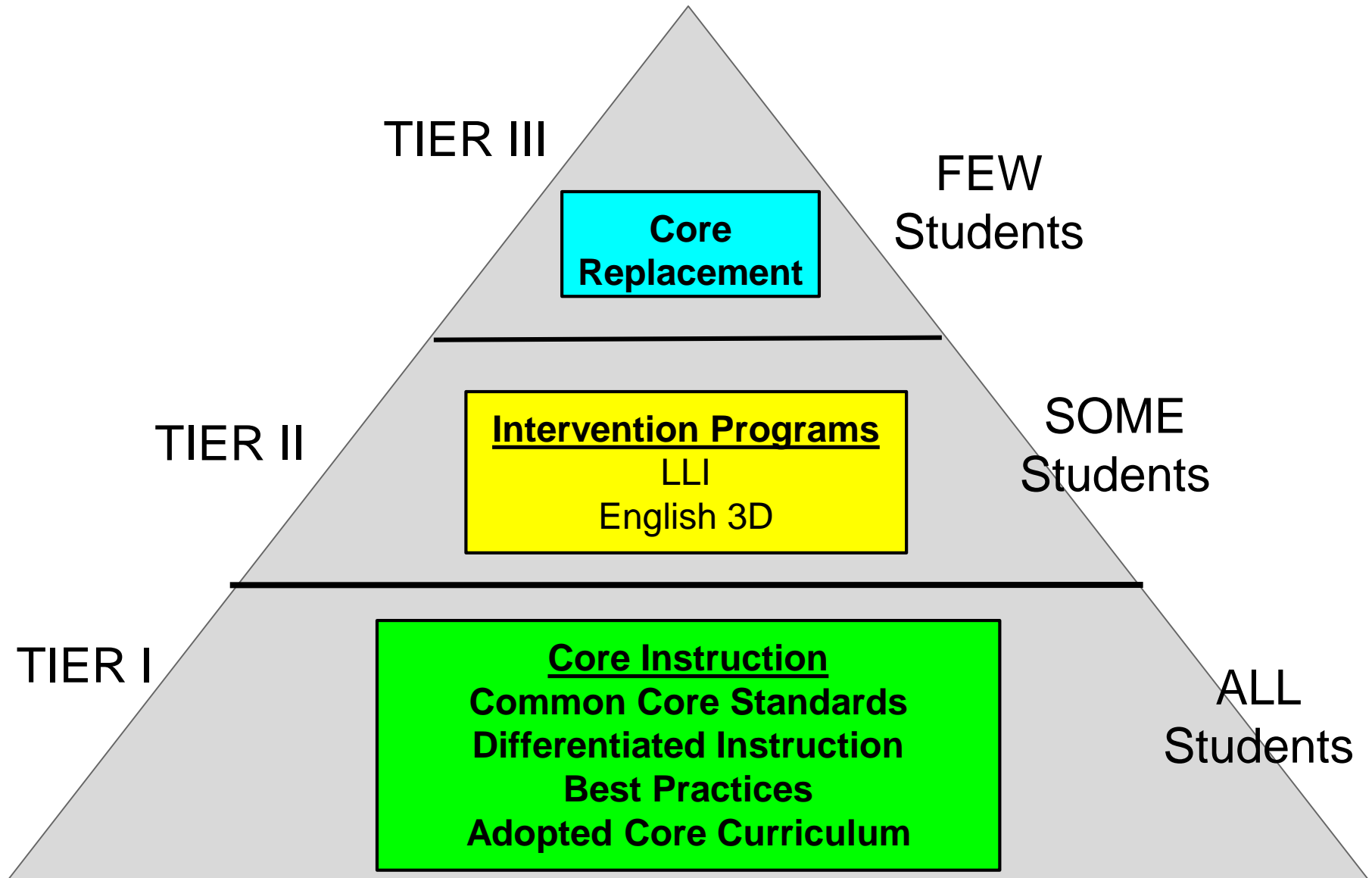
No significant change

Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC)	Spring	Grades 3-8 in ELA & Math Grades 5 & 8 in Science
District Performance Tasks	Ongoing (at least once per trimester)	Grades K-8 in ELA & Math
ELD Progress Profiles	Ongoing	Grades K-8 for English Learners only
California Physical Fitness Tests	Spring	Grades 5 & 7
Teacher Created Material/Text Support Materials	Ongoing	Grades K-8

What can YOU do?



- **Discuss daily learning with your child:** Ask about she/he is learning -ask “Why?” and “How?” – Reciprocate
- **Monitor progress:** Communicate with teachers, check Gradebook (6-8), check your child’s school planner
