Columbia High School is a 4-year high school with approximately 1341 students located in Nampa, Idaho. Students are required to earn 51 credits for graduation.

In the 2000/2001 school year the high schools within the Nampa District moved to a block schedule with an "A"- "B" block format. Students have four 87-minute classes per day. Students attend "A" day classes one day and "B" day classes the next. Students can opt for an 8, 7, or 6 period schedule.

Transcript

All classes taken by a student are included on their transcript with year, semester, and grade listed.

Advanced Placement courses are labeled as "AP".

College prep courses are labeled as "CP".

Students' weighted and un-weighted GPA's are listed as well as class rank with total students in the class included.
