- **PTO picnic lunch went well.** Need to address possible issues of more supervision of students on playground(parent volunteers or teachers)
 - Mr.Callus said he would make sure the playground is well staffed for next event

- **Grandparents Day** – Friday September 7: PTO asked room parents to have 36 cookies and 36 mini waters donate from each class by Thurs 9-6.
 - Mr.Callus asked that a few of the PTO members be present to help with pictures in the gym
- **Teacher’s Favorites** List- these lists have been emailed to room parents and a hard copy is on file in the front office.
- **Pretzels for Leo**-Jac has looked into bringing back the pretzels that were sold on First Friday as a student council fundraiser. Getting estimates and discussing scheduling with faculty.
 - Mr.Callus is all for some pretzels and we just need to figure out when and were to do the sales
- **Possible SPIRIT NIGHT’s** being determined(Chick Fila, Chipotle- they give 50% back)

 - Need to create a prize system (examples)
 - Over all First, Second and Third Place sellers(possibly gift cards \$100, \$75, \$25)
 - Highest over class sale(ice cream social/ cupcake/ pizza party)
 - Incremental sellers \$150-\$300 (out of uniform pass)etc.
 - Principal for a day(\$300-\$400)
 - Lunch with the teacher(\$300-400)
