



Update - March 2020

Non-Aggregate Feeding Plan during District/School Closure

In order to safeguard the health and safety of our students, yet continue to provide meal service during the coronavirus-related closure, Nutrition Services will enact the following plan:

- Begin distribution of reimbursable school meals beginning on Tuesday, March 17th (allowing one day for Nutrition Services staff to prepare for this transition)
- Distribute meals for all impacted students living in the surrounding areas at the following HUB sites:
 - DeMille Elementary
 - Anderson Elementary
 - Warner Middle School
 - Johnson Middle School
 - Stacey/Clegg School
- Meal distribution will be handled in a “drive-through” or “walk-up” manner in order to provide for social distancing. Parents will be asked to bring their students and to drive or walk-up through station to pick up meals from staff.
- Drive/walk-up through stations will be marked & located in the parking lot in the front of the school sites
- Meals will be distributed from 11:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. each day.
- Staff will hand packaged meals to parents through the car window or designated walk-up area for each child who is present and under 18 years of age. Each child will receive:
 - Lunch for that day
 - Breakfast for the following day
