Happy Friday!

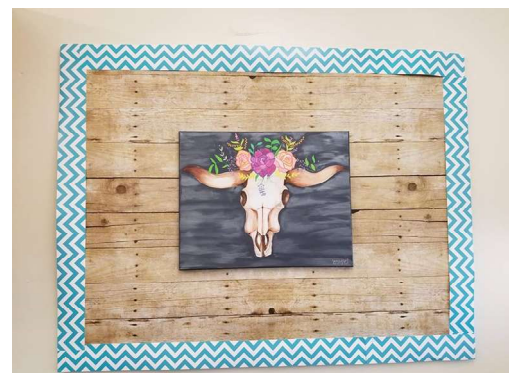
