MBA students must meet the PYLUSD graduation requirements of 230 credits for graduation.

Completion of the MBA Diploma requires students to:

- Complete above required courses
- Internship/Work Based Learning (CC or CVE)* course (150 hours/10 credits)
- Certifications Embedding in the Pathway (Culinary/Hospitality = ServSafe© or Business = Microsoft Office©)
- Recommended participation in a Career Technical Student Organization or academic competition team

* CC = Community Classroom & CVE = Cooperative Vocational Education
