Parents must complete all requirements of the Volunteer Handbook & Application, including a Live Scan FBI & DOJ fingerprinting and criminal background check. Live Scan results (both FBI & DOJ) must be received by TVCS Administration no later than January 15, 2020. We recommend having it done ASAP as we have no control over when we will receive the results. If you already have results on file with TVCS, you do not need to have another scan. One parent per child may attend this trip.
