Rule Number One – You must READ!

1. Read an RC Fiction book of your choice (or if your class does not take RC quizzes, then select one that you've used for a book report). The book must be one that we have at the Sierra Vista Library! Check our online catalog to see if we have the book.

Rule Number Two – The poster materials

1. The size of the poster must be 22" x 28" It may be white or have a background color. DO NOT use foam board.
2. Objects placed on the board may not extend over 2 inches past any edges of the board. Do not use any heavy materials that make it too difficult to hang up the poster. Please do not attach any food products to the poster.
3. Poster may be used either horizontally or vertically.
4. Lettering should be large, neat, and easily legible. Do not use abbreviations. Do not use peel and stick letters or computer generated letters/images for any lettering. Stencil use is okay. You may trace.

Rule Number Three – What goes on the front

1. Title of the book
2. Author of the book (use the full name, no abbreviations)
3. "Quotation" (**do not** put the page # of the quote on the front) The quotation must have quotation marks around it. The quote must emphasize the theme of the story. Do not hyphenate any words in the quote. The quote should be the caption for your illustration.
4. An original illustration. Nothing may be copied from any media regarding the book. Your drawing must be an illustration that goes with your quote.
