

## STUDENT DISCIPLINE

The following actions are listed in the Education Code (EC 48900 et. Seq.) as warranting consideration for suspension and/or expulsion from school attendance.

- A. (1) Caused, attempted to cause, or threatened to cause physical injury.  
(2) Willfully used force or violence upon the person of another, except in self-defense.
- B. Possession of a weapon or dangerous object.
- C. Possession of; use of; sales or furnishing of a controlled substance, alcoholic beverage or intoxicant.
- D. Offered, arranged or negotiated to sell a controlled substance, alcohol, intoxicant, but either sold, delivered, or otherwise furnished to a person an imitation.
- E. Attempted/committed robbery or extortion.
- F. Attempted/caused damage to school or private property.
- G. Attempted/stole school or private property.
- H. Possession/use of tobacco or nicotine products.
- I. Committed an obscene act or engaged in habitual profanity or vulgarity.
- J. Possession of/offered/arranged/negotiated to sell drug paraphernalia.
- K. Disruption of school activities; defiance of authority.
- L. Knowingly received stolen school or personal property.
- M. Possession of replica firearm.
- N. Attempted/committed a sexual assault or sexual battery as defined by Penal Code.
- O. Harassed, threatened or intimidated a student who is a complaining witness.
- P. Sale of prescription drug Soma.
- Q. Engaged in hazing.
- R. Engaged in an act of bullying, including, but not limited to, by means of an electronic act.
- T. Aided/abetted, or attempted infliction of physical injury.

### REASON FOR RECOMMENDING EXPULSION

**Education Code 48915(a)(1) requires a recommendation for expulsion for the following act(s) committed by a student unless expulsion is found to be inappropriate due to the circumstances:**

- 48915(a)(1)(A) Causing serious physical injury to another person, except in self-defense.
- 48915(a)(1)(B) Possession of any dangerous object.
- 48915(a)(1)(C) Unlawful possession of any controlled substance.
- 48915(a)(1)(D) Robbery or extortion.
- 48915(a)(1)(E) Assault or battery, as defined by Penal Code, upon a school employee.

**Education Code 48915(c)(1) requires immediate suspension and recommendation for expulsion for the following act(s) committed by a student.**

- 48915(c)(1) Possessing, selling or otherwise furnishing a firearm.
- 48915(c)(2) Brandishing a knife at another person.
- 48915(c)(3) Unlawfully selling controlled substance.
- 48915(c)(4) Committing or attempting to commit a sexual assault or sexual battery.
- 48915(c)(5) Possession of an explosive.

I have read this statement on student discipline and understand the severity of the above actions when committed on school grounds at any school activity or when going to or from the school or school activity. I also understand that suspension and/or expulsion are the potential consequences of these actions.
