ONLINE REGISTRATION & PAYMENT PROCEDURES FOR FALL 2019

Registration and payment for dual credit courses for qualified Grade 12 and Grade 11 students *currently enrolled* in any of the FHA courses listed below will be conducted *online*. The **cost for a SJU CAP course is \$325**. Students who enroll in a course and who then attend St. John's University the fall semester after high school graduation not only receive the credit and grade but also a \$2000 grant, each year of the four years you are enrolled in the University.

FHA Dual Credit Course Offerings -- Fall 2019

If you are currently enrolled in any of these courses and would like to receive college credit from St. John's University that is transferable to many other colleges and universities, you may register for up to **9 credits** (3 courses) per semester. **NOTE: IT IS THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY to inquire as to whether the college/university you would like to attend accepts SJU CAP credit.**

Most courses are year-long courses (total 6 credits with a second registration in the spring) EXCEPT for **Pre-Calculus H and Religion 12**, which are semester-long courses.

Request for Eligibility Criteria Verification

If you would like to register for a course/s, your **first step** is to **verify** your eligibility by emailing your request for SJU/CAP eligibility verification to Ms. Katherine Sollazzo, sollazzo@fontbonne.org in our guidance department. Please put “**SJU/CAP Eligibility Verification Request**” in the **subject** of your email. Indicate to her which courses you would like to register for. She will then check your eligibility as to whether or not you meet the criteria. This must be done **by close of school on Monday, September 23rd**.

Grade 12 students must have:

- a minimum cumulative average of **80%** in each of the five major subjects: English, World Language, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies
- a **minimum score of 1080 (combined critical reading and math) on the P/SAT OR**
- a minimum score of **21** on the ACT.

Grade 11 students must have:

- a minimum cumulative average of **85%** in each of the five major subjects: English, World Language, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies
- a **minimum score of 1080 (combined critical reading and math) on the PSAT/SAT OR**
- a minimum score of **21** on the ACT.

St. John's University On-Line Registration Process

Once approved by Ms. Sollazzo, you may proceed with online registration. You are to begin the process **as soon as possible**. Registration will be *live* from **now to close of business on October 2nd**. **This deadline must be adhered to!** It is important to note that:

- Information for payment will be communicated to you online. The payment deadline is **October 9th**.
- An online welcome email will be sent to your self reported email address. This will provide you with your **St. John's X #** and information as to how to pay online, by phone or by mail.
- Please note, failure to remit payment will result in all courses being dropped and registration rescinded. Once dropped from courses you will **not be reinstated**.

HOW TO APPLY TO SJU COLLEGE ADVANTAGE PROGRAM

Once approved by Ms. Sollazzo, go to www.stjohns.edu/ApplyCA . **PLEASE NOTE FOR SENIORS:** *This application system is different from that used for general undergraduate applications for St. John's. (Seniors who plan to apply for admission to St. John's for the Fall 2019 term should apply via the SJU App or Common App. Those applications are found at stjohns.edu/Apply.)*

If you applied for College Advantage for Fall 2018 and/or Spring 2019 terms, click the **LogIn button** and enter your email address and password on the next screen.

If you have not previously applied for College Advantage, complete the starred fields on the screen and **click the Submit button**.

Once logged in, you will see your **personal portal** screen.

Go to the portal area that lists any applications you may have previously completed. Beneath that section, click the blue **Create a New Application** link.



On the next screen, click the **Start a Fall 2019 College Advantage Application** button:

Complete all sections of the application, then click Submit.

- You will know you have successfully submitted your application when the confirmation page is displayed. **TAKE A SCREENSHOT OF THIS PAGE as Confirmation of Application.**
