

# Stacey Binder Requirements/Supply List

**Homeroom teachers will grade binders EVERY week.**

Score a 100% every time by doing the following.

- ✓ Keep your binder clean. Do not write on your binder.
- ✓ Insert all papers in the three rings. The binder must pass a “no shake” test, which means that when shaken, no papers or anything else fall out.
- ✓ Dividers will be used for Social Studies, Science, Language Arts, Math, and Reading.

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## Required Contents:

- 2 pencils
- 2 pens (black or blue)
- A composition notebook
- Stack of paper
- 4 different colored highlighters
- An eraser
- 5–8 labeled dividers (for all subjects in your binder)
- 2 Expo Markers
- A good quality 3–ring binder–2”, or 2 1/2”
- A zipped pencil pouch
- A glue stick
- An appropriate grade–level reading novel
- A backpack
- A school planner (will be provided by the school)

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## Binder Order:

1. Pencil Pouch
2. Planner
3. Dividers for each class to be organizer according to your schedule.
4. Within each subject, you should separate Cornell Notes, Classwork/Homework, and Tests/Quizzes. \*\*Students should create organized sections for Science, Math, Language Arts, Social Studies, AVID, and Electives.
5. You should have blank paper in the back of your binder.

\*\*\* Always put the newest work or handouts in front of the older papers.

Binder Decorations: Yes, you may personalize your binders but please make sure that it complies with Stacey’s school policy. We recommend that the binders maintain a college theme.
