MESSAGE FROM FINANCE OFFICE

Dear Parent / Guardian,

This is just a friendly reminder that if your account balance is 90 days delinquent, your daughter may automatically be suspended from classes and various school-sponsored excursions or activities, including athletic teams and pep squads until the delinquent balance is brought current. These absences will be considered non-excused. To avoid your daughter's suspension, if applicable, please manage and monitor your account balance at SmartTuition.com to review balances due. Also, if tuition and fees are not current, students will not be allowed to take finals and will be issued a 50% on the final exam (2018 -2019 Parent / Student Handbook, pg. 75). 2019-2020 TUITION ASSISTANCE APPLICATIONS ARE AVAILABLE

Catholic Education Foundation (CEF) and Saint Joseph High School (SJHS) tuition assistance applications are available in the Finance Office. Tuition assistance envelopes have been distributed to students currently receiving assistance. Please ask your daughter for the envelope and review instructions immediately as deadlines are approaching. If applying for CEF assistance, you must meet the income level guidelines and log onto the CEF website to schedule an appointment for Thursday, December 6th. Please contact the Finance Office at ext. 115 for further details or the 2019-2020 tuition assistance applications. If you are not currently receiving CEF assistance, do not schedule an appointment without contacting the Finance Office first.

DELIVERIES (straight from the handbook)

Deliveries of flowers, balloons, and food usually are not accepted by the front office. Lunch deliveries are only accepted from parents/guardians. **No food delivery services of any kind, such Postmates, Door Dash, Grub Hub, etc., will be accepted. Friends and/or boyfriends may not drop off student lunches.** The students have been told they are not allowed to use any delivery food services. Please remind your daughters if they have an order sent to the front office it will be turned away.

UNIFORMS

All students must be in complete uniform daily. No sweatshirts of any kind are permitted. Students may not wear tennis shoes; that is a senior privilege.
