- **All students are to take their exams at the assigned date/time. Exams may NOT be taken early for any reason. Make-ups will be scheduled only in cases of extreme illness or family situation. The request for a make-up must be in writing to the instructor and approved by the principal. The request must also include physician documentation of the illness.**
- **Students are not permitted to leave OR enter the classroom during an exam period.**
- **Bring something else to read or study in case you finish early.**
- **Please be courteous and do not disturb other students/classes that are still working.**

- Cumulative semester examinations in academic courses are given at the end of each semester for students in Grades 8-12. Exams for Grades 8-12 count as 20% of the semester average.
- For students in Grade 7, unit equivalent tests are administered as their “exam” per the schedule and counts as a regular test grade for the marking period.
- The exam schedule is published on our website. **All students are expected to take their exams at the scheduled time. Semester exams may NOT be taken early for any reason.**
- **Students with past due balances are not permitted to take exams.** All tuition and cafeteria accounts, fees, and fines owed to the school must be paid no later than **7 days prior** to exam week.
- Be sure to make arrangements for **ON TIME** arrival and pick-up.
- Tardy students will **NOT** be admitted to the classroom and will have to take a make-up exam with the teacher as noted on the schedule.
- All students must be picked up **within 15 minutes** after the stated dismissal time from school or practice. There is NO after school supervision during exam week.
- Students are not permitted to leave OR enter the classroom during an exam period.
- Students should bring something to read or study in case he/she finishes the exam before the end of the period or is present during a non-tested period.
- Some athletic teams may hold practices during exam week --consult the coach for times and make transportation arrangements as needed.
- Students are allowed to return to school for after-school activities if they are absent during a non-tested exam period.
- The cafeteria will have food service at the break time during exam week (except the last day).
- Students will continue to use their pre-paid funds on their cafeteria account in accordance with policy. Make sure that sufficient funds are sent for anticipated purchases as well as to pay any deficits.
- Dismissal time for each day is set so that students have ample time to go home for their own “instructional time” in preparation for the next day’s exams.
- Written assessments during an exam period are required for all courses except PE, Band and Study Hall. Students are not required to attend school for a period that does not have an exam or assessment. However, if your child is present at school during an exam period, he/she is required to be in the assigned room through the entire exam period.

Examples:

- *If the student’s only scheduled exam for the day is from 8:05am to 9:50am, he/she may be picked up between 9:50am and 10:15am in the pick-up line as usual. If the student is still present at school at 10:15am, he/she will be sent to the assigned room for supervision until 12:05pm.*
- *If the student’s only scheduled exam for the day is from 10:20 to 12:05am, he/she can arrive at school during the break time (9:50am to 10:15am).*
