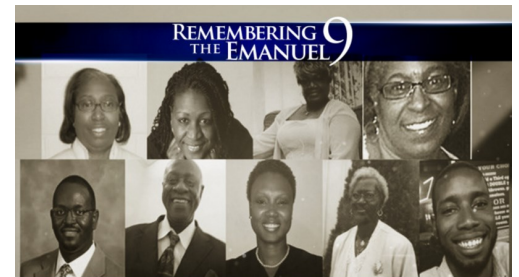

### Backpack Buddies Food Distribution Program

Last week, Hampton One started serving 175 elementary / primary students with a Backpack Buddy of food items for the weekend. The Backpack Buddy bags consists of 11 USDA approved food items. Over 700 bags were packed on Sunday, October 1st, at the Hampton United Methodist Church Social Hall. This project was made possible by a grant from **Lowcountry Ministries Fund**, an initiative of the **Palmetto Project**, through **Hampton-Varnville United Methodist Churches** in cooperation with **Lowcountry Food Bank**.
